When you reach the end of one year and begin another, it's a good time to take a breath and evaluate—to remember and count each blessing that God gave you. 2024 was a very difficult year, but God was faithful, and He sent so many good gifts along the way.

The best gifts of 2024 were 3 visas for Wismith. After being stuck in Haiti for several months when the Dominican border closed and they stopped giving visas to Haitians, we were finally able to travel again when Canada granted his visa renewal in January. Wismith's US visa had expired in 2022, and with the American embassy in Haiti being closed, we were unable to leave Haiti for almost 6 months.

...but God is good and He gives good gifts!

In April, we traveled to Canada and while we were there Wismith received a Jamaican visa. We traveled to Jamaica in June and renewed Wismith's US visa at the embassy there. We finally traveled to the US together for the first time in over 2 years! Our time in Canada and Jamaica felt like such a gift after the uncertainty and anxiety of being stuck in a country that was falling apart more and more every day. We had a beautiful time—but it still feels hard to be safe when we have so many friends and family who are not.

In July, we were back in Haiti doing our annual Youth Seminar when Ganthier (the town closest to us) was attacked and taken over by the 400 Mawozo gang. The gang had attempted the takeover numerous times, but they were always unsuccessful before. We, in Fond Parisien, always felt safer with Ganthier between us and gang territory, but that ended in July.

Our town has been protected so far by a small local "militia," a few policemen, a small outpost of soldiers, and a group of mercenaries hired by a local mission. There have been several attempts to attack and take over Fond Parisien since then, but so far we're still standing strong.

Praise God with us for allowing two of Wismith's siblings to immigrate to the United States last year. In the process of helping them get settled in Florida, we have experienced with them some of the enormous challenges faced by newly arrived immigrants.

Everyone who has any possibility of travel has left Haiti—many travel to Brazil, and many have traveled to the US through the Humanitarian Parole Program. It is a common assumption that immigrants entering through the Mexico border are illegal. However, everyone we know has entered the country legally and has official documentation to live and work legally in the US.

All that to say that there is a huge new immigrant population in the US, and many of them could use a helping hand as they start their lives over again in a new country.
