We arrived in Haiti on a Friday. The following morning, Wismith and some of his fellow pastors headed up the mountain to help officiate a wedding. We were privileged to go along and attend the wedding. It was interesting to see another part of Haiti. I am always amazed at how happy the people are even when they have so little.
